Announcements

Meeting led by Daine Wright:

- It's time for the annual Timberfest Chili Cookoff! Prepare your favorite chili recipe and bring your appetite! The cookoff is scheduled for Saturday, October 30th at 4:30. Set up will start at 2pm for anyone that wants to volunteer. This will be a free event, but donations will be accepted. Rain or shine!
- Greg has paid the City taxes. He intends to pay the County taxes as soon as he receives the invoice.
- The Maintenance Committee has started construction on the new shed at the pool. The shed will be used for chemical storage once completed.
- Daine obtained the EIN number. This will be used in the future to obtain full non-profit status.

Discussion

- Timberfest Chili Cookoff
 - There are still quite a few supplies left over from the last chili cookoff. Spoons, sample cups, and tickets for the voting are all available. There are also two table covers and half a pack of chili bowls; we will need more of these.
 - Power—Andrew has a generator to hook up the slow cookers. If anyone has a quiet generator with more than 1200 amps, please consider bringing it. Power can be run by extension cord from the Campbells' house. This will be used for the television and speakers if needed.
 - Tables—TRC has two tables that can be used. Extras may be needed if anyone in the neighborhood can help out.
 - Pop-up canopies—These may be needed if there is rain. A request will be sent out for neighbors to bring extras if needed.
 - Attendees are encouraged to bring a camp chair.

- Planning is still underway for prizes. Mariza suggested a Food City gift card as a prize. Greg Locke is contacting Bush Beans about a potential gift basket. Alex Thatcher may be providing a prize, also. (\$50 and a gift basket, \$25 and coffee, and \$25 are the projected prizes).

- Cornhole boards will be set up for entertainment.
