- Roof Replacement—The pool house needs re-roofing. Andrew spoke with Mark Moreland about the church roofing ministry. Mark is checking to see if there is availability to help any time soon. If that is not possible, a couple volunteers will be needed to assist with replacement.
- Chemicals—Chris is still planning to check with Keegan about wholesale chemicals. The Board will also research the other local companies for chemicals and chemical testing.
- Outreach—Daine has created a flyer for the Spring picnic. Volunteers will be needed to deliver to mailboxes.
- The upcoming pool board meetings are scheduled for April 20th and May 11th. Meetings will be held at 7pm at the pool unless weather is an issue. Please feel free to attend if you have any questions or would like to be more involved with the 2023 season and events.
